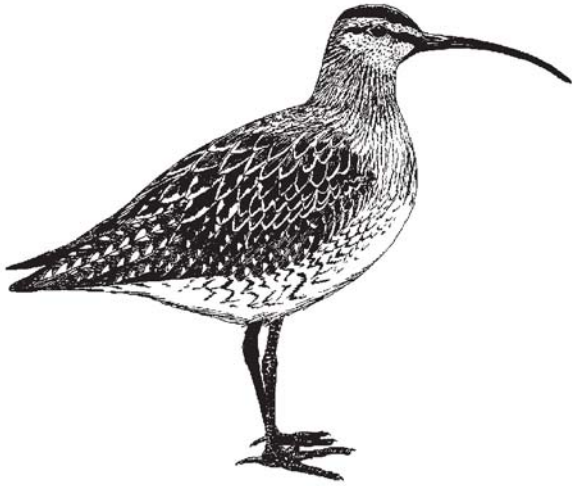
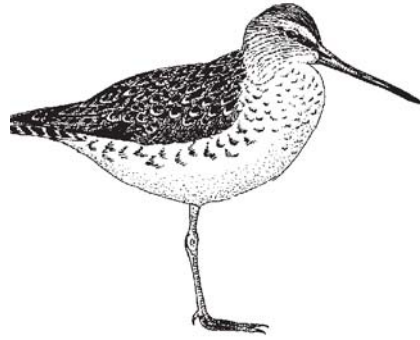


What Can I Eat With This Beak?

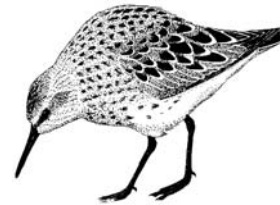

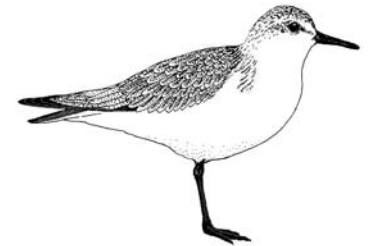
Whimbrel: I am a whimbrel. I use my down curved bill to probe very deeply into the mud for my food.
